



A hunter of the Massachuset tribe, 1600. The Massachuset people lived on the south side of Massachusetts Bay. The French explorer Samuel de Champlain met them during his explorations of the southern New England coast in 1605.

Both the French and the Dutch traded with the Massachuset people in the early seventeenth century, before they were largely destroyed by diseases brought to America by the Europeans between 1617 and 1633.
